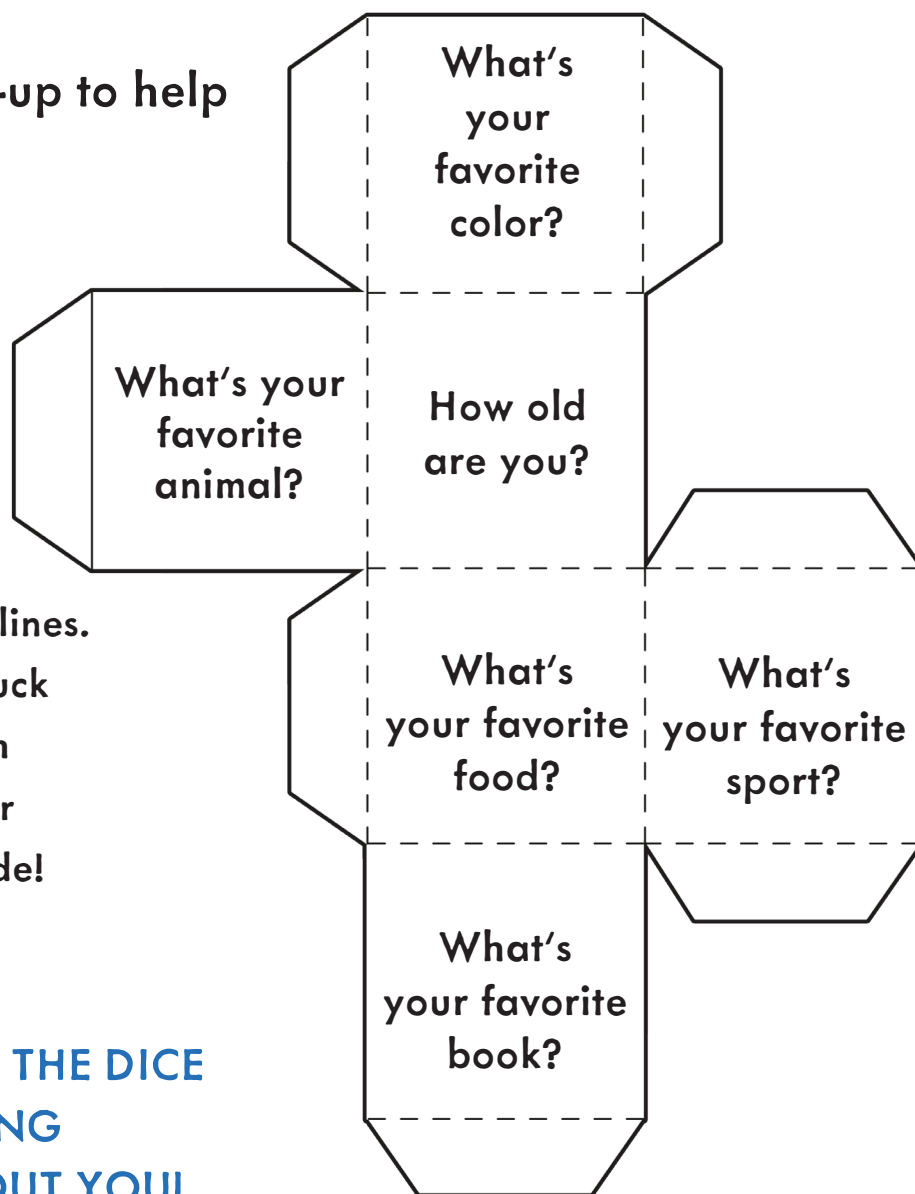
ICEBREAKER DICE GAME
